TROG 2020 Annual Scientific Meeting – Attendance Grant Guidelines

Technical Research Workshop (TRW)

The Technical Research Workshop (TRW) is a full-day workshop designed to encourage Radiation Therapist, Medical Physicist, and Radiation Oncologist researchers from Australia and New Zealand to participate in clinical trials and to promote the use of new technology in clinical research. The workshop is set out to share a broader perspective in issues relating to clinical trial conduct and associated technology. It focuses on the active participation of radiation therapists, medical physicists and radiation oncologists in clinical trials to support and enable technical research.

Eligibility Criteria

To be considered for a TROG Annual Scientific Meeting Grant, for attendance at the Technical Research Workshop (TRW), you must:

- Hold an affiliate or full membership with TROG.
- Work as a radiation therapist or radiation oncology medical physicist.
- Attend both the workshop and the main meeting (i.e. attending Monday through Thursday).
- Currently involved in TROG clinical trials.
- Have not received a TROG ASM Attendance Grant (Travel Grant) in the past 2 years.

Submission Instructions

Please complete the electronic application form which includes uploading the following two documents:

1. Supporting statement outlining the following: (word limit - 300 words)
 - What are your objectives and expected outcomes for ASM participation?
 - What is your current TROG clinical trial activity?
 - The positive impact your attendance has on your site/department.
 - How do you plan on contributing to the broader TROG community?
2. Letter of support from a full TROG member (word limit - 300 words)
